<b>Nature of matter:</b>	<p>The accused were charged of the following: Count 1 – Robbery with Aggravating Circumstances; count 2 murder; count 3 – Unlawful Possession of a Firearm; Count 4 – Unlawful Possession of Ammunition; Count 5 – Possession of a Firearm with Intent to Commit an Offence;</p> <p>Court held that there is no possibility of a conviction on counts 1, 2, 4, 5, other than if the three accused enter the witness box and incriminate themselves. In the circumstances they are entitled to be discharged on those counts at the close of the State case.</p>
