SUMMARY

MAKUME, J:

- Applicant and Defendant judgment in open court in terms of Rule 31(2)(a) read with Rule 31(5)(a)(b) of the Rules of Court.
- Such application bears characteristics of an exparte application.
 Applicant in such application required to makes full disclosure of all relevant factor.
- Plaintiff suing defendant for damages resulting from the sale of hypothecator property wherein Plaintiffs as mortgagers had defaulted

- in bond repayment. On sale such property mortgagers lost title to such property and not entitled to provide of subsequent sale to third parties.
- Failure to disclose full facts court justifies in its discretion to grant absolution from the instance
