## JUDGMENT

## **MALI AJ**

- This is an application for an order to rescind, alternatively to declare void and unenforceable the verdict issued by the third and fourth respondents on 18 July 2012. The application further seeks the following:
  - 1.1 an order directing the third respondent to reinstate the First applicants as members of the fifth respondent; and
  - an order directing the third respondent to reinstate the applicants as members of the fifth respondent and to renew their permits which they were entitled to as members of the fifth respondent.

[2] There was no appearance on behalf of all the applicants. I am satisfied that the notice of set down was served upon the applicants on 12 October 2015.

[3] Counsel, Mr Gwarha appeared on behalf of the 1st, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> respondents. Counsel, Mr Morare appeared on behalf of 5th and 11<sup>th</sup> respondent.

[4] There was no appearance on behalf of 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> and the 10<sup>th</sup> respondent.

[5] Having heard Counsel the application is dismissed with costs.

5.1 Applicants are ordered to pay costs of 1st, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> 5th and 11<sup>th</sup> respondents on attorney and client scale.
