THE CHAIRMAN OF THE STATE TENDER BOARD & ANOTHER v

SUPERSONIC TOURS (PTY) LTD

Supersonic Tours (Pty) Ltd tendered for, and was awarded, a contract

for the supply of travel services to the Department of Defence. The State

Tender Board subsequently disqualified Supersonic and its directors, for

a period of 10 years, from tendering for State contracts, on the basis that

Supersonic had acted fraudulently or in bad faith when it had submitted

its tender.

The SCA set the disqualification aside as Supersonic had at no time

been informed that the State Tender Board was considering disqualifying

it on either of the grounds relied on by the Board, and the Board's decision was accordingly held to be procedurally unfair.
